



Dear Coalition for Safe Drinking Water members:

Thank you for supporting [An Act Protecting Drinking Water Quality in Private Wells](#), which would enable the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) to develop a set of health-based regulations which would provide statewide water quality standards for private drinking water wells.

The legislation would grant MassDEP clear authority to establish standards and define testing requirements for new and existing wells to ensure effective implementation. Upon the sale of a home, a private well used for drinking water would have to pass a test for the transaction to be completed (similar to the state's Title 5 septic system regulations).

In addition, the state would make resources available to assist eligible homeowners with the cost of well water upgrades.
